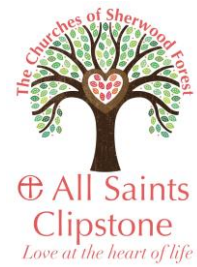




Clipstone Covid 19 Support Group

Do You Need Help? Do You Know Someone Who Needs Help? Clipstone Parish Council are working with local community groups (including All Saints Church) to help those with no support of their own. You should only use this service if you need to, please.

- We will ask you for your name, address, telephone number and what support you need.
- You should only use this support for errands, that would require you to leave the house such as collecting prescriptions, shopping, posting letters, collecting parcels and other similar activities. Volunteers should not carry out any jobs in your home or garden. Neither should they enter your home for a chat. You should not ask for services explicitly excluded. Both helpers and those requiring help should not be put at risk of infection in any way.
- Volunteers will arrange the shopping for you and collect/buy the items. They will take appropriate precautions to avoid spreading the virus through contact with the items.
- If prescriptions need paying for please arrange that with the chemist.
- For shopping, the volunteer will get in contact with you to tell you the bill. Payment by cash only; you will need to have the exact money to pay for the shopping when it is delivered.
- Any shopping must be delivered with the receipt and any change. **You must not give the volunteer your bank card, PIN or any personal bank details, nor must a volunteer ask for them.** Please report any breach of this policy to a co-ordinator immediately.
- No close contact is allowed between you and the volunteers, so please, leave cash in an envelope/yoghurt pot/disposable container on the doorstep and once you are safe inside the volunteer will collect it.
- Please keep a minimum of 2 meters distance at all times. Wash your hands after collecting goods.
